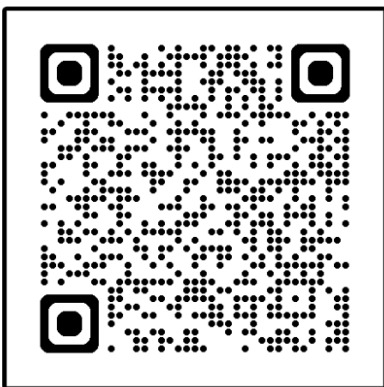


Child Safe Standards

Does your organisation meet the ACT Child Safe Standards?

From 1 August 2024, all providers of services for children and young people need to start implementing the Child Safe Standards.

Child safe organisations make sure children and young people feel safe and are safe

When organisations take actions to be child safe, child friendly and child aware, they help build a place where children and young people are valued and feel safer, and where abuse of children and young people is better prevented, responded to, and reported.

All staff and volunteers providing services for children and young people need to understand their role in helping their organisation put the Standards into action. This includes those staff and volunteers who do not need to have Working with Vulnerable People registration for their job.

The Standards will help organisations improve the way they uphold children and young people's human rights, in addition to improving systems and processes that promote and protect the safety and wellbeing of children and young people.

While there is no set timeframe for meeting all the Standards, organisations need to start implementing the Standards and work toward ensuring their organisation is a place where children and young people can both *be* safe and *feel* safe.
